



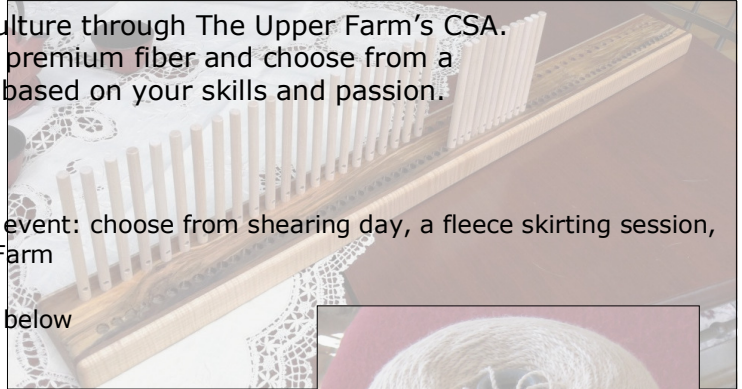
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Fiber through a CSA? Yes!

Spin It

Cost: \$160 (includes shipping every other month) or \$140 (p/u at farmer's market or the farm)

Yield: Three pounds of spinning fiber a year

Details: Every other month you will receive a half pound of skirted, unwashed, carded bats of alpaca fiber in various colors. Each bat will be a random one-of: some may be 100% white alpaca or combine different natural colors; some bats may be true black blended with another fiber in a natural or brightly dyed fiber. You never know what is coming until it's in your hands.

Accessories Share

Cost: \$64

Yield: A half pound of alpaca sport weight yarn in 2 or 4 ounce skeins (avg 60-75 yards per oz)

Details: Choose a half pound of yarn from any of our mill-spun fiber. Available in 100% alpaca or blended with other natural fibers like silk, merino and bamboo. Generally speaking, one skein will make a hat, narrow scarf, or a pair of small/medium sized mittens.

A Sweater's Worth

Cost: \$174

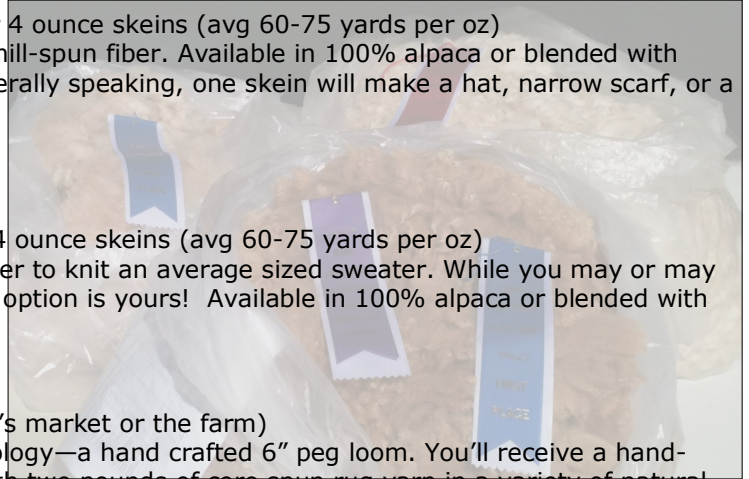
Yield: 1.5 pounds of alpaca sport weight yarn in 2 or 4 ounce skeins (avg 60-75 yards per oz)

Details: It takes about a pound and a half of alpaca fiber to knit an average sized sweater. While you may or may not wish to use your entire share on one garment, the option is yours! Available in 100% alpaca or blended with other natural fibers like silk, merino and bamboo.

The Primitive Weaver

Cost: \$250 (includes shipping) or \$230 (p/u at farmer's market or the farm)

Yield: Weave your own rugs using the simplest technology—a hand crafted 6" peg loom. You'll receive a hand-crafted loom with accompanying drilled pegs, along with two pounds of core spun rug yarn in a variety of natural colors.
